River Park Project

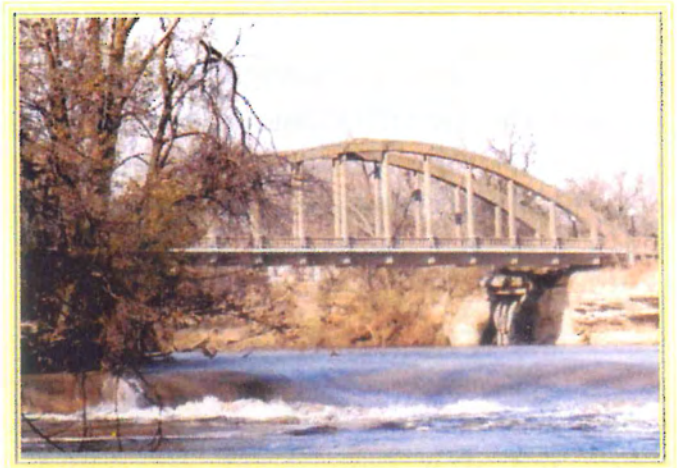

The Humboldt swimming pool is scheduled to open Sunday, May 23rd. Season passes can be purchased at City Hall at reduced rates for area residents. Pool parties can also be scheduled by calling the pool staff. This will be the second year after pool improvements were made including a zero depth entry area, new water features and improvements for handicap accessibility and to the pump house. Water Project Started

Northern Pipe Line from Topeka has started working on the City's \$1.6 million water line replacement project. Old lines will be replaced by polyethylene pipe which will significantly reduce water leakage. In addition, over 60 fire hydrants will be replaced improving fire protection safety in the City along with the addition of a new water valve system which will reduce the City's future maintenance cost.
