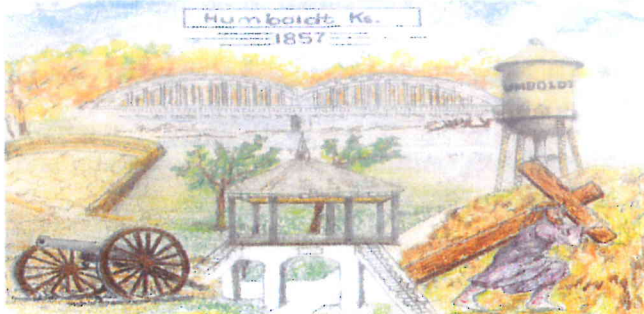

FIRE & STORM SIREN WARNINGS AND TONES

Enclosed in your utility bill this month are Fire & Storm Siren magnets that can be placed on a metal surface as a reminder of what to listen for in the event an emergency arises in Allen County or Humboldt.

- FIRE SIREN—SHORT HIGH/LOW TONES
- STORM SIREN—LONG HIGH/LOW TONES
- ALL CLEAR TONE—STEADY HIGH TONE
