## DOG & CAT REGISTRATIONS

It's time to renew dog and cat registrations at City Hall. All dogs and cats in Humboldt must be tagged and registered after January 1st. Tags go on sale Jan 2nd. Registration fees:

Dogs & Cats Spayed           \$5.00  
Dogs & Cats Non Spayed   \$10.00

The fees are due before March 1st. Late fees after March 1st are \$5.00. All new dogs and cats brought into the City of Humboldt must be tagged and registered within 30 days. When registering, be sure you provide copies of immunization records against rabies. For more information contact City Hall at (620) 473-3232.

## PLANNING COMMISSION TO STUDY ZONING REGULATIONS

For the past several months, the City Planning Commission has been working on updating the current zoning regulations. Much progress has been made, but more work is planned over the next several months,

including a public hearing to allow citizen comment. The next meeting of the planning commission will be on Wednesday, January 7th at 6:30 PM at the City Hall conference room.

## REPORTING GAS LEAKS

leak problem. After business hours or weekends, call the City water plant at 473-3131. Play it safe and let trained City personnel keep your house or business safe during this winter season.

## CITY CABLE TV CHANNEL COMING TO HUMBOLDT

Be watching on your local COX cable TV channel for the new Humboldt local government channel which will include City and School calendar updates, upcoming events and recorded videos of community school activities. Plans are to start the new channel after the first of the year.

## CITY APPROVES NEW FUND TO TACKLE DRAINAGE ISSUES

At its December meeting, the City Council authorized a new fund to address water drainage and storm water problems in Humboldt. Faced with aging drainage culverts and whistles and problems in controlling

water run off from surrounding agriculture land, the City will start collecting a \$1.00 fee on monthly utility bills beginning in January to help pay for City wide improvements.

## POOL CONSTRUCTION BEGINS

Construction has begun on the new swimming pool addition and upgrade. Carrothers Construction out of Paola is the general contractor. The pool improvements are expected to be completed in time for the 2009 season.

The City Council has also approved the opening of a new park south of the pool complex. Included in the park will be a new parking lot, picnic tables, playground equipment and a sand volleyball court.
