### Dog and Cat Registrations

It's time to renew dog and cat registrations at City Hall. All dogs and cats in Humboldt must be tagged and registered after January 1<sup>st</sup>. Tags go on sale January 4<sup>th</sup>. Registration fees:  
Dogs and Cats Spayed \$5.00  
Dogs and Cats Non-Spayed \$10.00  
The fees are due before March

1<sup>st</sup>. Late fees after March 1<sup>st</sup> are \$5.00. All new dogs and cats brought into the City of Humboldt must be tagged and registered within 30 days. When registering, be sure you provide copies of immunization records against rabies. For more information contact City Hall at (620) 473-3232.

## Sanitation Polycarts

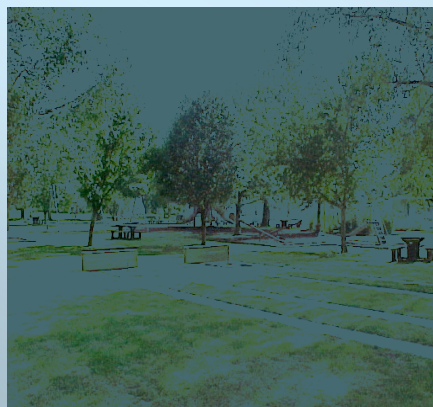
