

CITY OF HUMBOLDT
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
OCTOBER 16, 2007 - 5:30 P.M.

The Council met for a special council meeting on Monday, October 16, 2007, at 5:30 p.m. in the City Councilroom to discuss street improvements on north 8th Street.

Mayor Sharp called the meeting to order at 5:35 p.m. with the following Councilmembers present: Griffith, Julich, McReynolds, Weilert and Walburn. Councilmembers Murrow and Crawford and City Attorney Works were absent. Also present were City Administrator Tucker, Utilities Foreman Sanchez-Bosler, and Ken Shetlar-Shafer, Kline & Warren.

(5:36 p.m. Councilmember Aikins entered the councilroom and was seated).

Ken Shetlar said there are several options to remedy the poor and unsafe condition of the bridge on north 8th Street from Amos to Franklin. He said the City could accept bids for the repair work and present them at the November 19 regular council meeting in order for the work to begin as soon as possible.

(5:58 p.m. Councilmember Walburn left the councilroom).

City Administrator Tucker said, in the meantime, he and Utility Foreman Sanchez-Bosler will determine what can be done to make the bridge on north 8th Street safer until Ken Shetlar comes back to Councilmembers November 19 with different options for a permanent solution.

Motion by Weilert, second by Aikins to allow Ken Shetlar to research options for improvements to the north 8th Street bridge and present bids to be opened at the November 19 regular council meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by McReynolds, second by Aikins to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 6:00 p.m.
